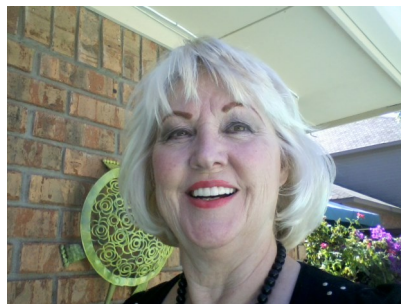

Acrylic Demo

Barvo is a prolific artist known for bringing out the sensitivity of his subjects. He has produced a plethora of work that includes children, families and prominent people. He has also created many sculptures of a spiritual nature for churches and public places. His work has found its way into museums and prominent places throughout the world.

His illustrations have appeared in such publications as the Robb Report, Southwest Art, Architectural Digest, Town & Country, Southern Accents and Veranda. In Europe his work has appeared in Debretts International Collection, Hilton Guest and Four Seasons.

Barvo was raised in Fort Worth, Texas and attended TCU, The University of Texas and the Baylor College of Dentistry. He left dentistry to enter the art world as a sculptor and painter in 1980 and has contributed works of art throughout the world since. He is here today to lecture on the subject and history of the use of acrylic paint in the art world.
